



**Tax Law & tax Treaties in Latin America**  
**International Tax Program Seminar at NYU**  
**October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010**

The seminar on **Tax Law, Transfer Pricing and Tax Treaty Practice in Latin America** is an all-day event scheduled to run from 8:30am through 4:00pm, to be held at NYU Vanderbilt's Greenberg Lounge on October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010, and sponsored by the New York University School of Law International Tax Program with the support of the law firms member of Latin America Tax & Legal Network – LATAXNET and the participation of NYU ITP alumni.

The Seminar will focus on three main topics, namely, recent significant developments in relevant jurisdictions, transfer pricing regulations and practices and current status of tax treaty negotiation and application throughout Latin America, addressing specific topics of interest for academics, students, and practitioners in a variety of Latin American jurisdictions.

Leading tax practitioners (many of them graduates from NYU, Harvard, and other international tax programs) will participate in the Seminar. Among jurisdictions participating are Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Mexico, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay and Venezuela.

The Seminar will consist of six different Panels which will focus in recent developments in transfer pricing and tax treaty negotiation, as well as other relevant issues for each jurisdiction with a dynamic and up to date view of the most interesting cases and issues in each jurisdiction.
